Each officer of a real estate corporation must be listed on the application form and at least one officer who intends to engage in or is actually engaged in real estate activities on behalf of the corporation must be duly licensed as a real estate broker. Other actively engaged officers may be licensed as salespersons. 2. An application fee of \$200 must accompany the application for a corporate license. Pay online at: https://www.realestatend.org/pay-bill (Reference: firm application), or in a check to NDREC. Cash not accepted. 3. A copy of the Articles of Incorporation must accompany the corporate application. 4. A corporation located in North Dakota must include a copy of the Certificate of Incorporation/Organization issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State. A non-resident corporation must also register with the North Dakota Secretary of State and submit with the corporate application a copy of the Certificate of Authority issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State authorizing the out-of-state corporation to transact business in North Dakota. The address for the North Dakota Secretary of State is: 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Dept. 108, Bismarck, ND 58505-0500. The Telephone number is (701) 328-4284. The website is www.nd.gov/sos. 5. Trade Names used in a real estate business must be registered with the North Dakota Secretary of State. A copy of the trade name registration must accompany the corporation application. See above address. 6. Out-of-state corporations must file an irrevocable Consent to Suit that actions may be commenced against the corporation in the proper court of any county in the State of North Dakota in which a cause of action may arise or in which the Plaintiff may reside, by the service of any process or pleadings authorized by the laws of the State of North Dakota. 7. The applicant for a corporate license must maintain an active place of business either in North Dakota or in the state of residency. A post office box number does not suffice. 8. A Consent to Examine Trust Account form or Request a Waiver of Trust Account form must be completed and returned with the corporate application. (See ND Real Estate License Law and Commission Rules and Regulations regarding trust account requirements.) 9. An Original Certificate of Licensure must be obtained from the licensing agency in any state in which the corporation is or has been licensed. The original Certificate must be dated within 30 days of application. <p style="text-align: center; margin-top: 20px;">The filing of an application does not entitle an applicant corporation to operate in the real estate business until such time as the North Dakota Real Estate Commission has issued the corporate or partnership license.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At least one partner in a partnership who is actively engaged in real estate activities on behalf of a partnership must be duly licensed real estate broker. The other partner or partners may be licensed as salespersons. 2. A fee of \$200 must accompany the application for a partnership license. Pay online at: https://www.realestatend.org/pay-bill (Reference: firm application), or in a check to NDREC. Cash not accepted. 3. When a partnership submits its application for a license, a copy of the partnership agreements must accompany the application. 4. Trade names used in a real estate business must be registered with the North Dakota Secretary of State. A copy of the trade name registration must accompany the partnership application. The address for the North Dakota Secretary of State is: 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Dept. 108, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505-0500. The telephone number is (701) 328-4284. The website is www.nd.gov/sos. 5. Nonresident partnerships must file an irrevocable Consent to Suit that actions may be commenced against the partnership in the proper court of any county in the State of North Dakota in which a cause of action may arise or in which the Plaintiff may reside, by the service of any process or pleadings authorized by the laws of the State of North Dakota. 6. The applicant for a partnership license must maintain an active place of business either in North Dakota or in the state of residency. A post office box number does not suffice. 7. A Consent to Examine Trust Account form or Request a Waiver of Trust Account form must be completed and returned with the partnership application. (See ND Real Estate License Law and Commission Rules and Regulations regarding trust account requirements.) 8. An Original Certificate of Licensure must be obtained from the licensing agency in any state in which the partnership is or has been licensed and doing business. The original Certificate must be dated within 30 days of application.

The \$200 fee can be paid online at: <https://www.realestatend.org/pay-bill> (Reference: firm application) or by check to NDREC, and must accompany this application. Cash is not accepted. Application must be carefully and legibly printed or typed. Every question must be answered or the application will be returned for completion.

For out-of-state firms applying for a North Dakota firm license, the original Certificates of License (COL) issued within 30 days of the application from every state in which the applicant is or has been licensed must be included with this application.
